Botta also left his marks in Athens, the Buildings of the National Bank of Greece and of the National Insurance Company in Sygrou are a testimony of his architectural vision.

I would like to thank the Dean of the Faculty of Architecture, Irini Klabatsea, and Professor Ioannis Yannoutsos for hosting this event at the historic building of the Polytechnio.
