METROREX PROGRAMME COMPONENTS:



In order to improve the access to the Bucharest metro for people with disabilities/reduced mobility, the first component aims at contracting an entity that will firstly assess the current situation of the metro network and infrastructure, followed by developing a comprehensive strategy mainly focused on inter-modality solutions, and finally by presenting an investment plan. The entity is to be selected following a public procurement launched by Metrorex S.A.

Once the investment plan is developed, technical designs and procurement for the necessary infrastructure will be prepared, by prioritizing the needs. In addition, based on the comprehensive strategy proposed under the first component, METROREX S.A will start to implement the proposed measures.
