WITHDRAWAL OF RESERVATIONS BY CANADA

By note of October 28, 1982, registered on October 29, 1982,
the Canadian Embassy at Bern has informed the Federal Department
of Foreign Affairs of the immediate withdrawal of the following
reservations :

Appendix II

Ursus arctos, brown (grizzly) bear
Ovis canadensis, bighorn sheep
Anser albinfrons gambelli, tule white-fronted goose
Sei whale comprises North Pacific and South Atlantic
stocks.

Fin whale includes all stocks except stocks in the North Atlantic off Iceland and Newfoundland, and stocks in the Southwest Atlantic and Southeast Pacific oceans. Brown bear comprises all North American subspecies".

The present notification is addressed to the Governments of Signatory or Contracting States in conformity with Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention.
