AMENDMENT OF JUNE 22, 1979 TO THE CONVENTION

The Federal Department of Foreign Affairs informs the Signatory or Contracting States of the Convention that the following States, by depositing an instrument with the Swiss Government, have accepted the Amendment to Article XI, Paragraph 3, sub-paragraph (a), adopted at Bonn on June 22, 1979:

Italy	on November 18, 1982
Chile	on November 18, 1982
Seychelles	on November 18, 1982
Tunisia	on November 23, 1982

The Amendment shall enter into force, for the Parties which shall have accepted it, 60 days after two-thirds of the Parties shall have deposited an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment with the Depositary Government.

The present notification is addressed to the Governments of Signatory or Contracting States in conformity with Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention.
