

Spouse: if they do not bear the same surname as the principal beneficiary, the Organisation must join a copy of the marriage certificate.

<sup>&</sup>lt;u>Cohabitant</u>: who is considered by the Organisation as an official partner or as a dependent.


<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Additional documents to be submitted for each child:

If the child does not bear the same surname as the principal beneficiary, the Organisation must join a copy of the birth certificate.


If the father/mother is divorced or separated, the Organisation must join a copy of the decision of parental authority for the minor child (under 18 years old).

If the child is adopted, the Organisation must join a copy of the certificate of adoption.

Further children have to be listed on a separate and signed form.
